

Use the Roxio Video Capture Device

Please note before getting started: The length of time to make a digital copy will be the same length of time as the video plays (i.e. if it's a 2 hour VHS tape it will take 2 hours to copy).

- 1) Ensure the Roxio Video Capture USB device is connected to a USB 2.0 port on your Mac, and that your VCR or analog video source is connected to the Roxio adapter.
- 2) Double-click the Roxio Video Capture icon to launch the application.




- 3) Select a name for your recording. The name you select will be used as a filename for the captured video. Tip: We suggest using a name that will uniquely describe the recording — for example, an event name or a date.
- 4) The input source should already be set to the Roxio Video Capture Composite.
- 5) Select a video quality. High is recommended.
 - a. High (Apple Intermediate): This is the optimal quality option and default selection for capturing video. This is also the ideal setting for users who want to edit their video in iMovie after capturing.
 - b. Medium (H.264 640x480): This option captures video in full resolution using the H.264 format. It should only be used by advanced users who will be processing video using other tools after capture. Video captured at this quality will be interlaced, which causes the appearance of horizontal lines during playback.



How to...

- c. Low (H.264 320x240): This option captures video in a lower resolution using the H.264 format. It should only be used by advanced users who will be processing video using other tools after capture. Video captured at this quality will be interlaced, which causes the appearance of horizontal lines during playback.
- 6) Rewind or fast-forward to the specific point of your video that you wish to capture.
- 7) Click Play on your VCR or other video source. When the preview window shows the point from where you would like to begin recording, click the Record button. You should see the bar in the readout box moving to indicate the sound is being recorded.




8) Click the Stop button when you would like to stop recording.



How to...

9) Trim the beginning and end of the video if necessary. Use the button to split the video if necessary.



10) Click the Finish button to save your video. Recordings are saved in the Roxio Video Capture folder located inside the Movies folder.
