




The Raven Boys

by Jonathan Stroud


Follows three young operatives of a Psychic Detection Agency as they battle an epidemic of ghosts in London.

by Natsuki Takaya


Tohru Honda is an orphaned teenager who comes to live with the Sohma family in exchange for housekeeping duties, but she soon comes to know the family secret.

by Shaenon K. Garrity





Real-life cases tell the history of modern forensic science, from the first test for arsenic poisoning to fingerprinting, blood spatter analysis,



by Laura Pohl


After an alien attack devastates the Earth, pilot and future astronaut Clover Martinez bands with seven other teens in a struggle to survive.


