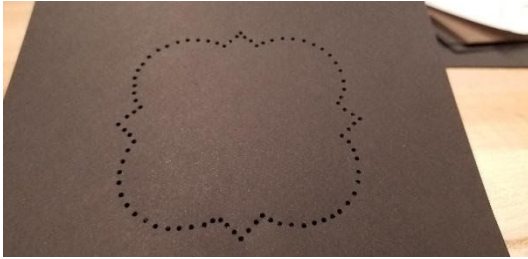
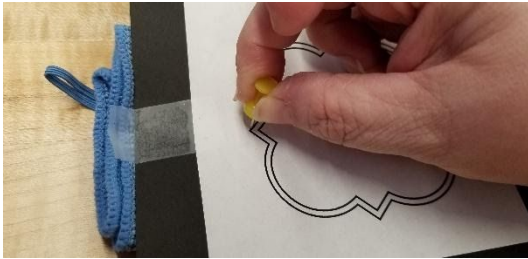


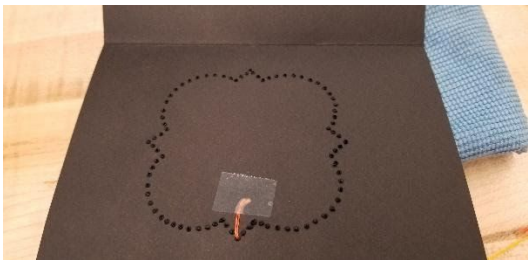
Hand Stitched Cards

Supplies: blank card, embroidery thread, needle, tape, stencil, thumbtack

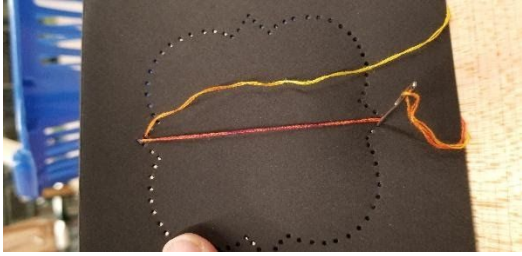
1. Choose stencil and thread.
2. Layer in this order: towel (bottom), card, and stencil.
3. Use thumbtack to make holes around stencil about 2mm apart.



4. Thread needle and push the needle through from inside of card using top middle hole. Tape thread down (do not worry about the tape showing we will create stickers to cover this up).



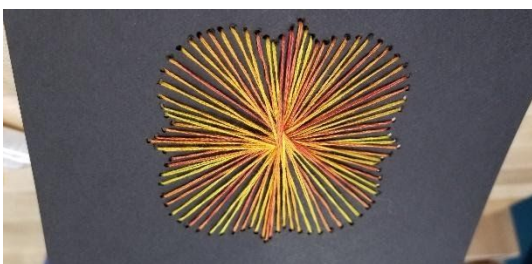
5. Go to the hole directly across and push through. Flip card over and make a stitch to the right.



6. Flip card over and push needle through the hole to the right side of the first stitch. Pull through and flip card over and make a stitch to the left. Flip card over and insert needle left of the most recent stitch. Pull through, flip over, and continue.



7. Done!



Tips

- Do not pull too tight as it will rip the card.
- If there are more holes on one side of shape you can double up at the end or add extra holes.
- Cover the tape and thread inside with paper using the Xyron Creative Station to apply Permanent adhesive.
