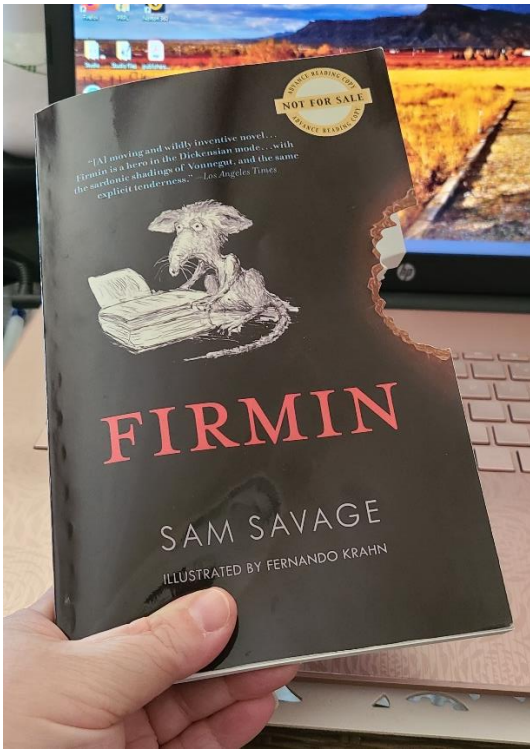
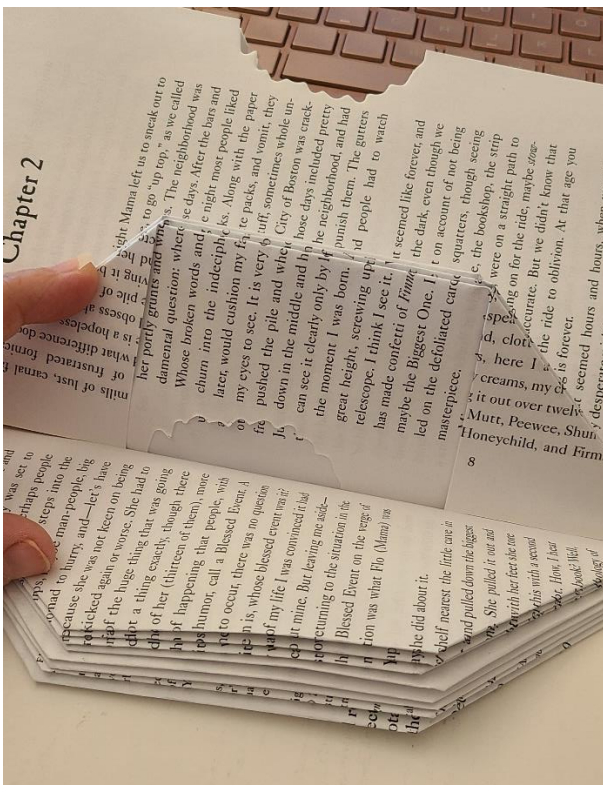


How to Make Your Own Book Hedgehog

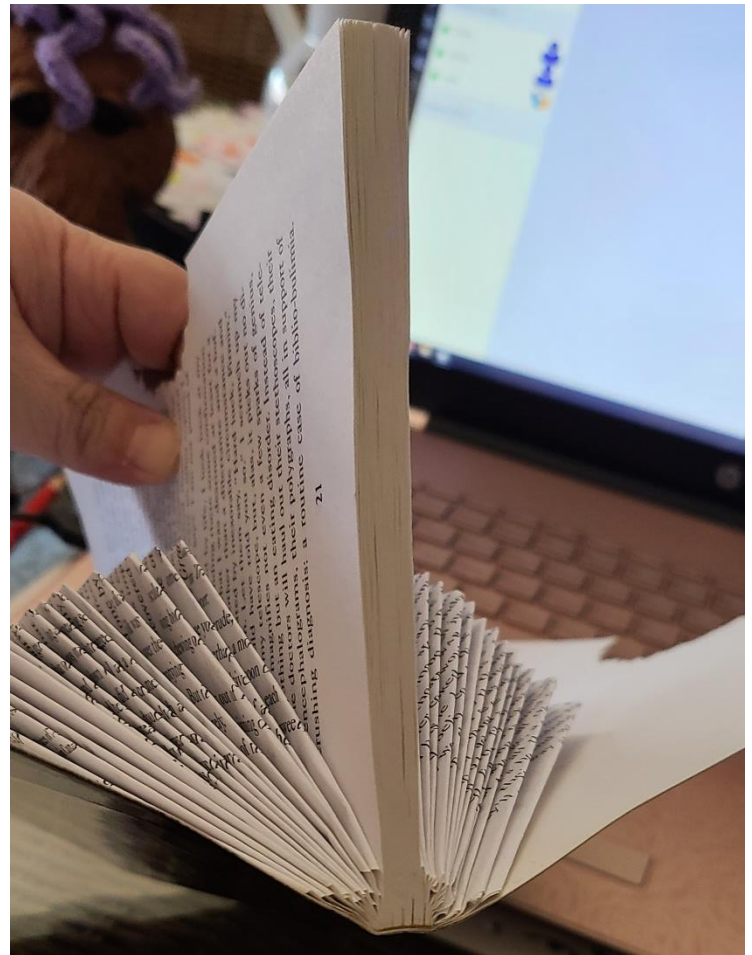
Start with a book you don't want any more. Somewhere between 100-200 pages works best. Paperbacks are the easiest to work with. This one had 166 pages and seemed particularly appropriate.



Start by folding the pages in half. Then fold back the corners, as shown in the picture.



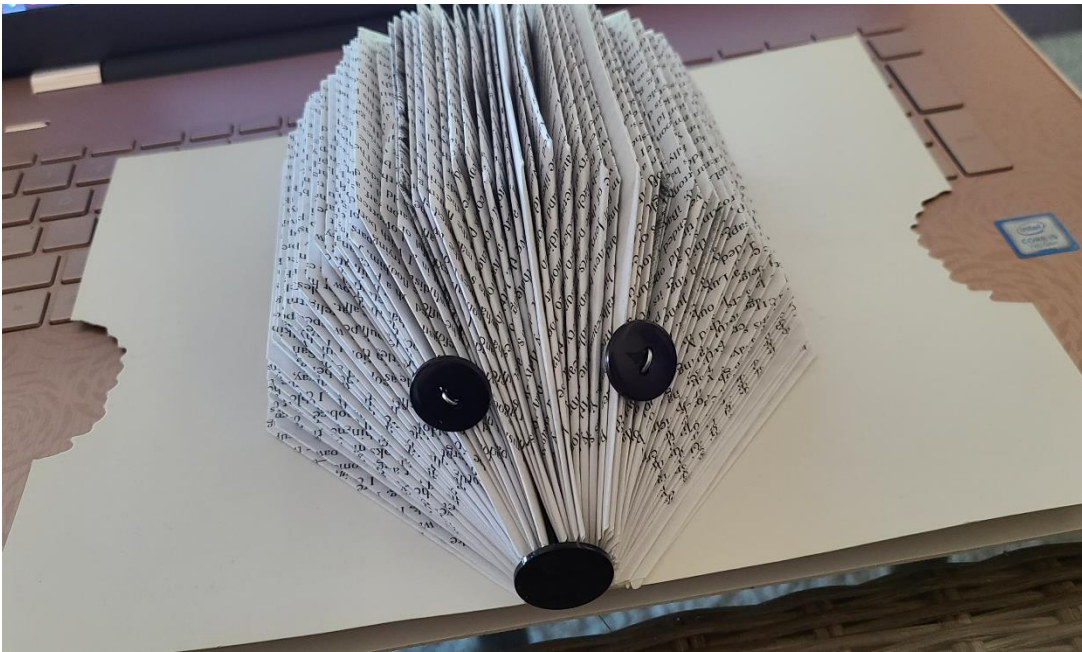
Continue with all the pages in the book. I alternated from side to side, but you can work from one side to the other. Whichever is easier for you. You can see him start to take shape here.



After a lot more folding, you'll have something like this. Now he needs a face. A few old buttons should do the trick!



I used paperclips through the buttons and tucked them in between the pages. You can trim the cover of the book to match the shape of the pages if you want or even decorate it!
