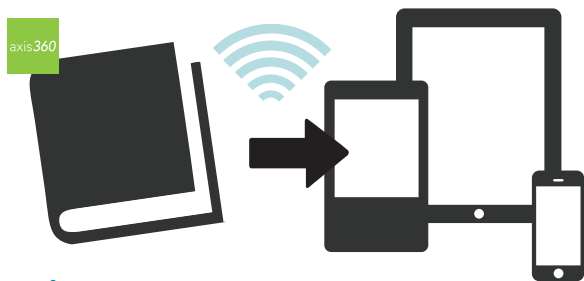


# HOW TO

use **Axis360** to Download Library eBooks or eAudiobooks onto your Tablet or Smart Phone



## Devices:

Use the app on iPad, iPhone, iPod Touch, Android, and Nook HD.

## Here's What You'll Need to Get Started:

- 1 Go to the App store on your tablet/smart phone and download the free **Axis360** app.  
**Note:** If you haven't already, you will need to authorize your device with an Adobe ID. Tap **Need Help with Adobe ID** and follow the instructions, then return to **Axis360**.
- 2 Open the app and tap **Skip to find your library or school now** at the bottom of the screen.
- 3 Search for **Park Ridge Public Library** in the search box.
- 4 After the app locates the Library, enter your library card number where it says **Library ID** and then tap **Login**.
- 5 Your **My Library** page will load and you can begin to browse for audiobooks. Tap **Browse** at the bottom of the screen or use the **magnifying glass** in the top right corner for specific titles.

## To Download an eBook or eAudiobook:

- 1 Once you've selected the title you want, tap **Checkout**.  
**Note:** If the title is not available, you may put a hold on it by selecting **Place On Hold** and entering your email address.
- 2 Select **Continue Checkout**.
- 3 Tap **Listen Now** to begin listening for an eAudiobook title or **Download Now** for eBooks.

## Read, Listen & Return a Title:

- 1 After downloading, your title can be found in **My Stuff**.
- 2 If you want to return your title early, visit **My Stuff**. Tap the title cover and choose **Return**.

## Things to Remember:

### CHECKOUT LIMITS

You may check out 5 titles at a time for a 3-week loan period each. You may also place 5 holds at a time. When your title is due it will automatically expire from your device.

### ADDITIONAL EAUDIOBOOKS AND EBOOKS
