



# Downloading content using the Libby for Overdrive app

#### Create an account

- 1. Download the Libby for Overdrive app from your device's app store.
- 2. Open the app and follow the prompts to find your library and sign in with your library card number.

## Borrowing items

- 1. Browse the categories, or search for specific items by typing in the search bar.
- 2. Select an item, and press Borrow to check it out. If the item is checked out, click Place Hold to be added to the holds list.
- 3. Borrowed titles appear on your Shelf and download to the app automatically when you're connected to Wi-Fi, so you can read or listen to them offline.

#### Tips:

You can switch between your borrowed items and the library by tapping Library or Shelf at the bottom of the screen.

If you prefer to read on a Kindle device, choose "Kindle" as the format type, and follow the prompts to checkout the book via your Amazon account.



### Overdrive FAQ

1. What's the difference between Overdrive and Libby?

Overdrive provides eBooks and eAudiobooks to library patrons worldwide.

Libby is the app used to download content from Overdrive

2. What devices is Libby compatible with?

Libby is available for Android, iOS, Windows 10, and some Chromebooks.

3. Can I download the content for offline reading or listening?

Yes, content can be downloaded to mobile devices using the Libby app, or sent to Kindle via Amazon.
