The Library's Strategic Planning Process




Earlier this year, the Library embarked on a new strategic planning process to map out our mission, vision and roadmap for the next four years. The most valuable phase of planning was recently concluded: patron and community input. We heard from more than 2,000 community members


ranging in ages from middle school to seniors via an online survey, in-person feedback sessions and engagement activities at our local schools. While many insights were highlighted during this process, one thing stood out to the Library Board of Trustees: the strong positive feedback about the Library staff and the impact they have on patrons.

This summer, a select group of Library staff, trustees and community members will meet with our partner *ReThinking Libraries* to comb through Library usage data, community feedback and industry insights to develop the plan. We hope to have the plan approved by the Library Board in August 2025 and shared with you soon after. Thanks to all of you who generously gave time and shared your opinions and ideas during this process.




