What is it?

Use for heat transfer projects.

What can I do with the Powerpress Heat Press and Cricut Easy Press?

Customize fabric materials such as tote bags, pillows, and t-shirts. Designs can be created by cutting heat transfer vinyl or infusible ink with the Cricut or Silhouette Cameo machines.

What can I do with the Cricut Mug Press?

Customize mugs using infusible ink sheets with the Cricut machine or infusible ink pens.

Material to customize

Heat transfer vinyl or infusible ink cut with Cricut or Silhouette machines

Cricut mug blanks or [Cricut compatible mug blanks](#)

Cricut Infusible Ink sheets or Cricut Infusible Ink pens (pens provided)

1 sheet of laser copy paper (if using pens)

3 layers of copy paper (if using pens)

- Try a slightly lower temperature or less time than you think you'll need and add more if necessary.
