SECRETARY’S REPORT

In Secretary Kiem’s absence, Trustee DeFrank reviewed each of the PRPL website and press articles included in the Secretary’s report on page 19 of the packet.

DIRECTOR’S REPORT

Director Bertucci provided highlights from the Director’s Report beginning on page 21 of the packet and noted the following:

- The PRPL Strategic Plan trifold summary was distributed to trustees and Director Bertucci will be mailing these to all who participated in the June strategic plan retreat day. They will also be made available to patrons in the library.
- Baker & Taylor’s closure, and the implications it will have on library collections and operations, were detailed by Director Bertucci. As they were the primary source for acquisitions, their closure will result in delays in acquiring new materials. Although other vendors can be used, the books received from them will not be “shelf-ready” as they were when purchased through Baker & Taylor. The library’s marketing staff is developing messaging to inform patrons of the expected delays and of alternatives that can be used to mitigate the impact of the closure. In the interim, the library will increase purchasing of digital materials.
- In September, the Persons in Charge staff were all trained in the administration of NARCAN, as state law that will become effective January 1, 2026, requires that at least one staff member on duty at all times be trained in this.

FRIENDS OF THE LIBRARY REPORT

Director Bertucci noted that the Friends completed the Fall book sale last weekend and despite having one-third less physical space in the meeting room due to the HVAC project, they generated over \$6,000 in revenue! Also noted was the upcoming Friends fundraiser at Fire & Wine, scheduled for Thursday, October 23.

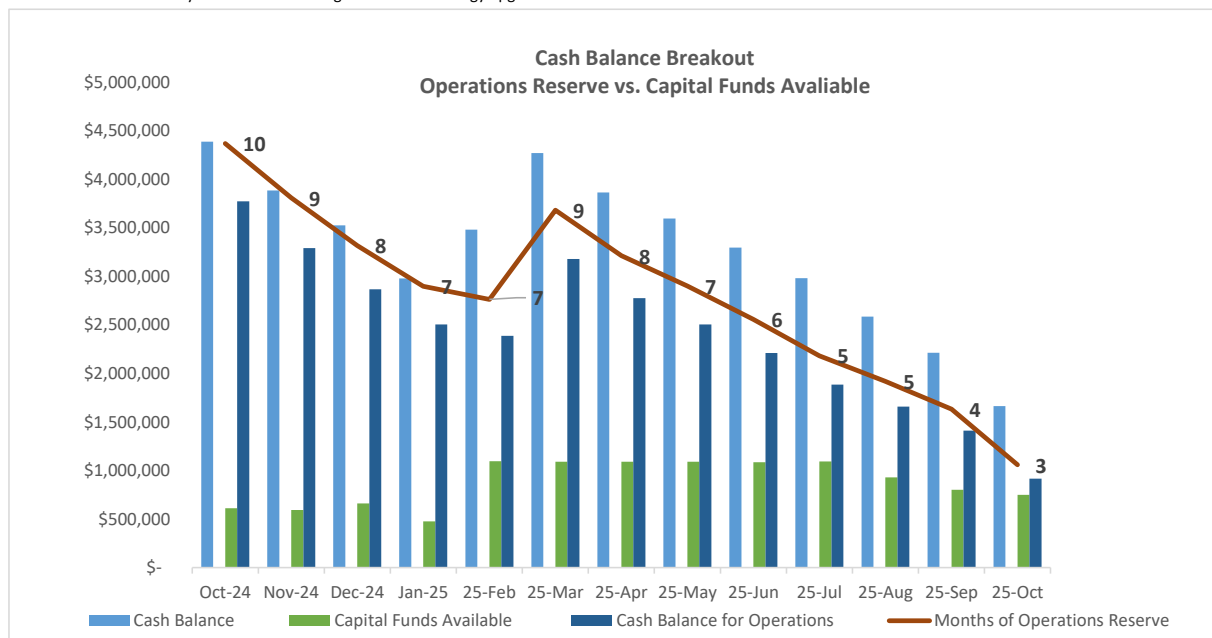

Background:

The FY25 Budget for Computer Equipment (201-5011-990800) was increased from \$50,000 with February 18, 2025 Budget Amendment to Carry Forward \$86,919.00 from the FY24 Computer Equipment Budget. The revised budget of \$136,919 was set to purchase computers for the library and staff. We are allocating \$150,000 of the Michel Trust (\$223,095.30 as of Sept. 30, 2025) to cover the costs of new PCs and installation for the library. The Michel Trust was with Northern Trust Bank. It was established for Technology expenses for PRPL. This Budget Amendment will cover the \$13,081 necessary in the budget line to pay the remaining invoices. The Michel Trust funds will be deposited in the Revenue-Contributions account (201 875500) of the Library Fund.

Subject: Payroll Services contract for 2026-2029

Background:

The Payroll Services Contract for PRPL is currently held with ADP and is set to expire on January 3, 2026. In preparation for securing a more advantageous agreement, I researched three different payroll service providers and am sharing the results of my negotiations below.

Based on the evaluation of available payroll service providers, it is recommended that PRPL renew its contract with ADP for an additional three years. After significant negotiations, ADP presented a highly cost-effective proposal, offering savings of approximately **\$13,000** compared to the **current contract with PRPL \$26,797.10** and about **\$3,500 - \$5,000 less** than competing bids annual expenses. Renewing the contract will ensure continuity of service, alleviate transition costs (\$1,500 - \$2,500, respectively), and maintain compliance with all payroll and tax reporting requirements.

The proposed renewal involves **no transition expenses**, offers total savings through our 3 year contract of **\$39,079.65**, and ensures **a seamless experience for employees**, making this the most advantageous option for the Park Ridge Public Library.

Background

As part of the Library’s Year One Strategic Plan initiatives, staff identified the launch of a mobile app as a key project to advance our goal of investing in technology and improving digital access and ease of use. Following strong interest expressed during the June 2, 2025, Strategic Plan Retreat, where a mobile app ranked as the top new service priority, I began exploring potential vendors. Initial research showed that our current calendar platform, LibCal, is incompatible with most mobile app solutions designed to integrate program calendars and online collections within a single, user-friendly interface. To address this, we sought an all-in-one platform that could meet both staff and patron needs. An interdepartmental evaluation team—comprising Sarah Vessalo (Adult Services), Jen Healy (Marketing), Sara Trivedi (Administrative Services), and Alyssa Barrett (Youth Services)—reviewed three vendors recommended by our consultants and peer libraries: Communico, BiblioCommons, and Solus. The following summary outlines the team’s findings for each. All vendors offer customizable graphics, fonts, and color schemes to ensure the app aligns seamlessly with our branding guidelines.

Communico

Pros	Cons
<p>The Communico platform offers integrated solutions within a single app environment, providing the ability to easily create programs, customize registration forms, and track changes across multiple users, but with notable advancements. Each event automatically generates a QR code and printable brochure for patrons or staff, making promotion and access easier. Communico offers text reminders and easy Zoom integration, which would expand our reach and make hybrid programs easier to schedule and easier for patrons to attend.</p> <p>The Reserve module for room and asset booking is particularly impressive, offering fully customizable options for each space, including setup and teardown times, an area that would represent a significant improvement over our current process.</p> <p>Finally, we’re hopeful that Challenge, a forthcoming feature expected in December 2025, will serve as a replacement for Beanstack, allowing us to bring event management, reservations, and reading programs together under one cohesive platform.</p>	<p>The team did not identify any drawbacks to the Communico platform.</p>

Bibliocommons

Pros	Cons
<p>The BiblioCommons suite offers most core functions within a single, integrated app experience. BiblioApps provides a patron-facing mobile app for both iOS and Android devices, while BiblioEvents supports comprehensive event and program management, allowing patrons to easily browse, register, and engage with Library programs directly through the app.</p> <p>In 2026, CCS will transition to the BiblioCommons discovery layer, which would create a seamless experience between desktop catalog searching and the mobile environment.</p>	<p>While we appreciated certain features of the BiblioCommons app, such as the option to add a library card to Apple or Android Wallet, the requirement to log in before accessing any part of the app poses a significant usability concern. Since our goal in implementing a mobile app is to make library services more accessible, requiring users to log in immediately could create a barrier.</p> <p>Additionally, BiblioCommons does not include a reservation system for meeting rooms or other library assets, meaning we would need to continue using LibCal to manage those functions.</p>

Solus

Pros	Cons
<p>The Solus platform, developed by Innovative Interfaces, offers an integrated mobile app solution designed to connect directly with the library's catalog and patron records. The app provides access to account management, digital collections, and event listings through a patron-facing interface available for both iOS and Android devices.</p>	<p>Solus initially appeared to be a natural fit given its integration with our catalog and patron records. However, we quickly found that its program registration functionality is too closely tied to library barcodes. Many of our programs, particularly for children, do not require a library card to register, and Solus offers no workaround for this limitation within either the app or the desktop calendar. As a result, patrons would need to call the library to register, which undermines the goal of providing a convenient, self-service mobile experience.</p> <p>Additionally, registration forms cannot be customized beyond a single open text field, and options to collect additional participant information are limited.</p> <p>The overall event calendar design, essentially a text-based list with minimal graphics, felt like a step backward from our current interface.</p> <p>Finally, the room reservation system mirrors the same limitations we currently have with LibCal, requiring patrons to often call or use a separate online form for assistance since room bookings are not handled separately from event scheduling, which would again lead to overlapping reservations.</p>

<p>Through the RAILS Group Purchase Program, Communico is offering discounted pricing to participating member libraries, including a waiver of their \$4,250 implementation fee. The cost would be \$8,500 per year for three years, for a total investment of \$25,500.</p> <p>By moving to Communico, the Library would be able to discontinue LibCal, resulting in annual savings of approximately \$1,900. In addition, if staff choose to implement the Challenge module as a replacement for Beanstack, the Library will realize an additional \$1,500 in annual savings in FY26.</p>	<p>The BiblioCommons proposal includes a one-time implementation fee of \$6,375 and an annual cost of \$7,904 for three years, for a total investment of \$30,088.</p> <p>Because BiblioCommons does not include a meeting room or asset reservation system, the library would need to continue using LibCal for this function at an additional annual cost of \$1,900.</p>	<p><i>As of 10/30/2025, I have not received pricing from Solus, despite several requests.</i></p>

Recommendation

I recommend that the library move forward with Communico, with the project scheduled to kick off on January 1, 2026. Trustees who wish to preview the Communico platform can download the Las Vegas-Clark County Library District (serves Las Vegas–Clark County, NV) or Ela Area Public Library (serves Lake Zurich, Kildeer, Hawthorn Woods, & Long Grove) apps from the mobile app store on their device.

Suggested Motion

Approve a three-year contract with Communico for implementation of its integrated mobile app, event, and room reservation platform through the RAILS Group Purchase Program for a total of \$25,500 for 3 years.

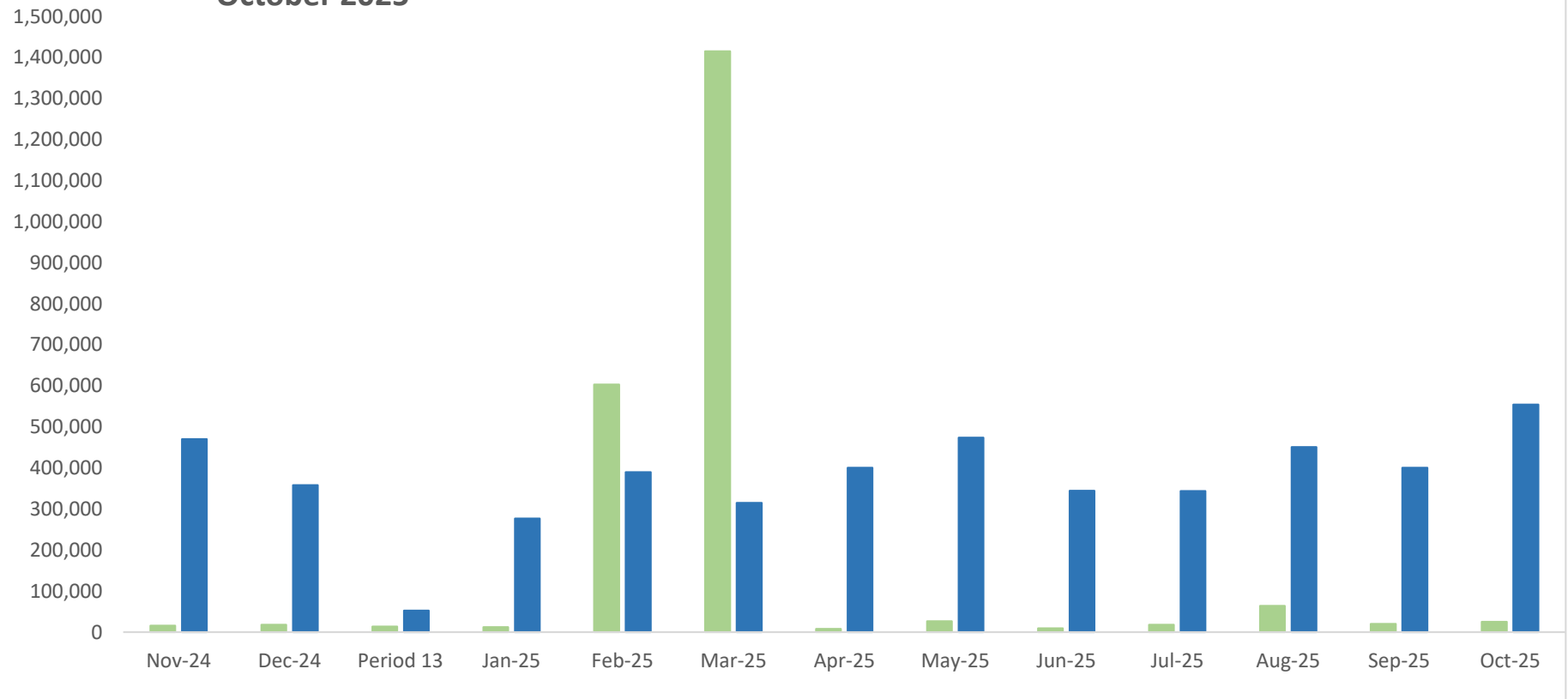

Administration & Board:

- Carnegie Corporation of New York has announced the Carnegie Libraries 250 initiative in honor of the United States' upcoming 250th anniversary. Through this program, every eligible Carnegie-funded public library, approximately 1,280 nationwide, will receive a \$10,000 gift in January 2026. Importantly for us, the Corporation has confirmed that the gift will be directed to all Carnegie libraries regardless of whether they still occupy their original Carnegie buildings. Because Park Ridge Public Library was originally established with Carnegie funding, PRPL will be a recipient of this \$10,000 award, even though we no longer inhabit our original Carnegie structure. Libraries may use the funds at their discretion. In January, I will bring a recommendation to the Board regarding the allocation of this generous gift.
- In late October, the Sitkiewicz family generously donated an additional \$6,000 to support ongoing Marion's Mark adult programming. These funds most notably sustain our *Global Neighbors* quarterly series, which celebrates cultures from around the world through food, storytelling, and music. The series honors the memory of the late Marion Sitkiewicz, her love of global travel, and her deep connection to the Park Ridge Public Library. Marion's Mark funds also support our monthly *Read to the Dogs* children's program, reflecting Mrs. Sitkiewicz's lifelong love of reading. We are deeply grateful to the Sitkiewicz family for their continued generosity and for helping us share programming that embodies Marion's spirit and enriches the lives of our patrons.
- At the November 12 CCS Governing Board meeting, Directors voted to approve membership applications for the Wauconda Area and Rolling Meadows Public Libraries to join CCS, bringing the total number of member libraries to 33. The addition of these libraries will add approximately 300,000 items to CCS holdings and may help offset the roughly \$2,000 in member fee increases discussed at the May Governing Board meeting. Wauconda and Rolling Meadows are expected to go live in Fall 2026. Additionally, the CCS FY25 Annual Report is attached to this report for those interested in learning more about CCS.

Strategic Planning:

- I sent our signed contract to David Vinjamuri at ThirdWay Spaces and have confirmed that Mr. Vinjamuri will be onsite Tuesday, January 6 and Wednesday, January 7, 2026. In an effort to share more about his process and answer any questions, Mr. Vinjamuri suggested that Trustees and a few members of library staff meet for dinner on Tuesday, January 6. Interested Trustees should reach out to me directly. I would like to limit trustee participation to two members so as to be in compliance with the Open Meetings Act.
- We will begin sharing announcements about the Strategic Plan the week of November 17 with a dedicated web page with the mission, vision, and values and links to download the synopsis (brochure) of the plan and a more detailed report, which will also be in flipbook form. Items in the weekly eNewsletters will also promote and drive traffic to the webpage, as will social media posts and signage around the building. Copies of the plan were made available to all June 2 retreat participants and to members of City Council and the City Manager in October.

Staff Updates and Professional Development:

- On Wednesday, October 15, 30 members of library staff received CPR/AED training from Lt. Frank Villari of the Park Ridge Fire Department. We are grateful to Lt. Villari and the team at the PRFD for all the ways they support the library and the community.
- Long time custodian, Paul Pandocchi, announced his retirement in September. Paul has been with the library since 2007 and is retiring on December 1. We extended an offer of employment to Mr. Keith Dunlap, who will start at PRPL on Monday, November 17. Mr. Dunlap has ten plus years of experience working in facilities departments at the Wilmette and Skokie Public libraries. We are excited to welcome him.



Finance and HR:

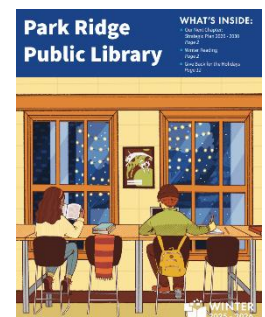
- Ms. Wrenn met with representatives from Time Bank in Park Ridge and established a Money Market account at 3.75% to deposit the Michel Trust payment of \$187,000. The remaining \$40,209.03 (as of September 2025) will be held by The Northern Trust to cover taxes and fees, with a final payment issued after that reconciliation is complete. The library will deposit \$150,000 of these funds into the operating account to cover the cost of the new PCs.
- The library recorded \$850 in revenue from the sale of surplus computer hardware to staff. Remaining monitors were donated to local libraries and nonprofits. Facilities Manager John Priala is working with a technology equipment recycler to dispose of the remaining PCs. We anticipate an additional \$3,000 in revenue from this effort.
- Ms. Wrenn arranged for representatives from the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund (IMRF) to present to participating staff on Wednesday, November 12. 18 staff members attended to learn about their IMRF benefits and ask questions.
- The library presented our 2026 budget and 2025 levy request at the City's Budget Workshop on Monday, November 17 at 7 pm.

Building and IT:

- Mr. Priala continues to expertly manage the HVAC project. Contractors are currently completing the ductwork in both the mechanical room and the meeting room. We anticipate that the temporary wall in the meeting room will be removed by November 21, restoring the space for regular use.

Marketing:

- The Winter issue of the print newsletter will start arriving in homes the week of November 24, Thanksgiving. The issue will focus on the strategic plan rollout and promote Winter Reading and opportunities for giving back over the season.



Outreach and Community Engagement:

- Eighty-five community members participated in the Hearing & Vision Screenings bus hosted in partnership with the Park Ridge Lions Club on October 3.
- Youth Service Manager Staci Greenwald and Library Specialist Karen Black represented the Library at the Park District's annual Trunk-or-treat event on Friday, October 24, at the Centennial Fitness Center parking lot. Over 400 kids stopped by the library trunk to collect treats and the occasional trick of Miss Karen's skeleton hand.

- Marketing Coordinator, Jen Healy, and I represented the library at the Park Ridge Farmer’s Market on October 25. We interacted with approximately one hundred community members promoting library services and programming.

Notable Programs, Collections, and Services

- **Boundless/eRead Illinois Platform Transition Update**
 - Following Baker & Taylor’s abrupt closure, the Boundless app that hosted the eRead Illinois collection is being discontinued. RAILS is coordinating a rapid transition to The Palace Project, a sustainable, library-focused platform that will aggregate e-books and audiobooks from multiple vendors and offer improved licensing terms. Effective Immediately no new holds may be placed in Boundless; existing holds and checkout histories will not transfer. On November 17 Boundless will be nonfunctional; content migration begins. On December 2, The Palace Project app launches statewide, restoring access to the full eRead Illinois collection. The Adult Services and Marketing teams are preparing patron-facing communications, so we are ready for a smooth rollout.
- Youth Services staff have completed the transition from iPads to Launchpads in the Children’s Department and now offer six tablets for families to use while in the library. Following the accountability model used in Adult Services for study rooms, families check out a tablet by leaving an adult’s ID or library card at the desk. Feedback has been overwhelmingly positive, and families appreciate that the tablets are no longer in plain sight as a distraction; and those who wish to use them understand and value the new system.
- Patron Services took over the processing of Museum Adventure Passes from Youth Services in October. This transition was made to streamline the Museum Pass checkout experience for patrons.
- We hosted a special story time with Park Ridge Fire Marshal Kevin Plach, on Saturday, October 4 in honor of Fire Prevention Week. During the event, Lieutenant Plach dressed in his full firefighting gear piece by piece, allowing children to see and touch each item as he explained its purpose. This hands-on demonstration helped demystify the equipment and ensured that firefighters feel less intimidating to young patrons. Families shared very positive feedback about this engaging and reassuring program.



- Adult programs kept pace this month. 52 history buffs showed up for *This is Really War: The Incredible True Story of a Navy Nurse POW in WWII* and 45 trivia nerds joined me for Library Pub Quiz. On October 28, 38 aspiring travelers gathered for *Global Neighbors: Korea* while 32 music fans enjoyed our latest Friends concert, the *Jazz Arts Duo*.

Our Mission and Vision

Our strategic goals for this year included updating our mission and vision:

Mission: Enhance each cooperative member’s capacity to serve their patrons through optimized resource sharing, a community of continuous learning, and strategic cost-sharing.

Vision: CCS members are thriving—empowered by collaboration and technology to meet the diverse needs of their communities.

Our Guiding Principles

The guiding principles underlie all of the work CCS does and are the driving forces in CCS decision making.



We support resource sharing.



We foster a culture of collaboration and community.



We provide professional development, training, and networking opportunities.



We adopt those technologies and services which enhance the user experience.



We practice fiscally responsible stewardship of member library resources.



We engage all member libraries and respect their diversity.

Strategic Initiatives

In 2021, CCS Governing Board adopted five strategic directions to ensure CCS continues to work towards our stated vision. In FY2024-2025, CCS completed the following initiatives to support those strategic directions.

Develop flexible, responsive services that will continue to improve the patron and staff experience.

Engage Governing Board in a strategic planning process

The Long Range Planning Committee and R. Malinowski conducted a strategic planning process in FY 2025 resulting in a plan approved by Governing Board in May 2025. The process included research into other consortia plans and services, surveying library directors and CCS staff, analyzing Polaris satisfaction, and facilitating discussions with the Governing Board. The new plan covers 2025-2030 and will be revisited annually.

Develop a more accessible format for library staff to view existing Polaris policy tables and adopt a standard workflow for submitting requests

R. Barth developed a tool to give more insight into one of the most complex tables powering Polaris, the material type loan limits table. Working with V. Seward, Barth gathered library staff feedback before publishing the tool. [Tool Documentation](#)

Strategically build membership to further promote resource sharing in Illinois.

Develop framework to assess the impact of Find More Illinois on CCS patrons, library staff, and library budgets

R. Fischer, D. Wischmeyer, R. Barth, and K. Lyons collaborated to collect data on the interlibrary loan process, including lending/borrowing statistics from Find More Illinois and OCLC, staff time, and costs. An initial presentation of the analysis is planned for November 2025 Governing Board.

Successfully onboard the Vernon Area Public Library

The Vernon Area Public Library began circulating in September 2025, on schedule. M. Landers led the project for CCS, and all staff contributed to its success. Due to inconsistencies in last year's data loads and this year's test data load, an additional day was added to the offline period. CCS staff will work with Innovative to identify potential causes of the increase in processing times and work to reduce member downtime. A more robust report on the migration as a whole is in progress.

Identify and pursue new opportunities for enhancements of core ILS services to improve patron and staff experiences.

Compare Vega Discover with PowerPAC and in-market discovery layers

G. Shah conducted a multi-phase comparative study between Vega Discover, Bibliocore, and Aspen, including gathering feedback from patrons, member library staff, and CCS staff. Shah's findings indicated that Bibliocore and Vega Discover received similar scores overall, with each presenting unique advantages. After an additional set of presentations to the Governing Board, the Board selected Bibliocommons as the CCS-wide discovery layer in September 2025. Implementation will begin in FY 2026.

Evaluate available services for phone notifications and identify optimal service for CCS prior to contract renewal

M. Landers researched available phone notification providers and recommended moving to UniqueManagement's MessageBee Phone service. This service's advantage over Innovative's PhoneAlerts is primarily that each library can have a unique caller ID. Both services are cloud-based which will allow CCS to decommission an aging server and associated analog telephone lines. Implementation will be complete by Spring 2026.

Help libraries use ILS data effectively for internal decision-making and communication with stakeholders.

Evaluate in-market data analytics tools and incorporate findings into strategic plan

Following the Governing Board's strategic data needs brainstorming, R. Fischer and G. Shah synthesized the Board's data needs. Fischer led an investigation into in-market tools. R. Malinowski projected potential costs for an in-house developed tool. Fischer recommended Orange Boy's Savannah as a centralized analytics tool to support member library strategic decision-making. R. Malinowski presented to the Board in May 2025 and implementation will begin in FY 2026.

Continue to focus on providing value to CCS members through fiscally responsible stewardship of member library resources.

Prepare for and begin ILS contract renewal

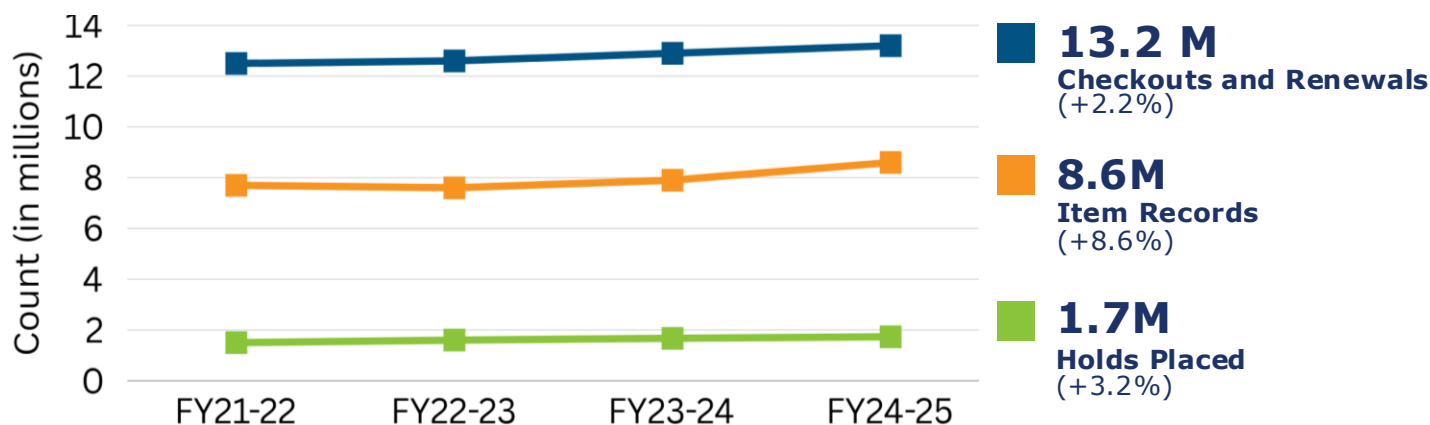
D. Wischmeyer conducted and analyzed a detailed Polaris Satisfaction Survey, which was shared with membership in January 2025. The results of the survey were incorporated into the strategic planning process, discovery analysis, and contract renewal process. Library directors were separately asked about overall value of Polaris in the strategic planning survey.

D. Wischmeyer and R. Malinowski met with other Polaris customers to discuss the pain points of their contract negotiations to set expectations for our own process. R. Malinowski began contract negotiations with Innovative Interfaces in May 2025, and the process was put on hold until Governing Board's discovery layer decision in September 2025.

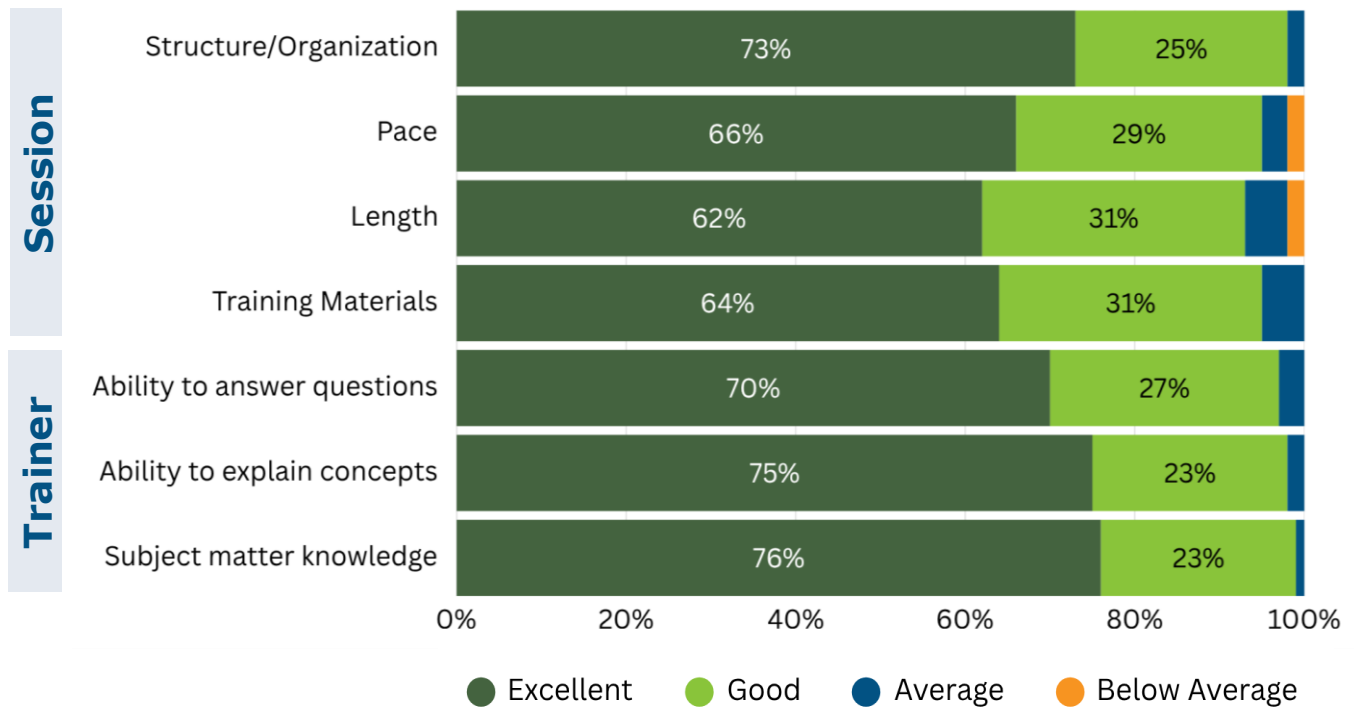
